## President's Message

My last President's letter was lengthy, so I am limiting this month to a quick update during the legislative year.

This is another busy week for the 82nd Session of the Nevada Legislature. During Nevada Governor Joe Lombardo's State of the State address in January, he announced his two-year proposal package with an 11 million dollar budget. This week, the budget package bill is scheduled to be introduced.

Friday, March 27th, is the deadline for legislators and committees to introduce bills. Although there are almost 1,000 bills to consider, they are still coming. Here is an overview of a few of the bills freshly introduced.

- Assembly Bill 195, introduced by Assemblywoman Melissa Hardy (R): Waiver of standard noncommercial driver's license fees for released prisoners.
- Senate Bill 78, Democratic, introduced by Senator. Fabian Doñate (D): Limitation of application fees a landlord can charge prospective tenants and prohibits landlords from charging fees that have more than one application for the same unit at the same time.
- Assembly Bill 224, introduced by six sponsors and 24 co-sponsors: This bill would treat higher education faculty as other state employees and put them under the same collective bargaining structure as other state employees. Primary sponsors:

Assemblywoman Shannon Bilbray-Axelrod (D)
Assemblywoman Sarah Peters (D)
Assemblyman Howard Watts (D)
Assemblywoman Selena La Rue Hatch (D)

You most likely get many emails regarding "calls to action" for our members to provide public comment (which can be done online), and it might seem like it's a bit overwhelming to read and respond to all of them. Do remember that the legislators pay attention to the number of comments of support or opposition when making their decisions.

Take care, and we hope to see you soon at our club meetings.
