President's Message

On April 17th a large group from the Nevada Federation of Republican Women descended on the Capitol for Legislative Day in Carson City. I was in attendance and wanted to say what a great day of communication we have with our legislatures. I

have attended legislative day functions for many other groups, and I have to say this one was one of the most organized as we had a positive impression with our presence and rapport with our elected officials.

For those who have never been to a legislative day, normally there is a meet-up and instructions where you break up into groups to speak to officials. This event was held in the same format, however, it highlighted that the Sierra Nevada Republican Women are present and we have valuable information and opinions to offer. It was great to see the halls filled with proud Republican women sporting red and wearing the Nevada Federation of Republican Women monogrammed shirts.

We were graciously invited to meet with legislators. My group was assigned to meet with Assemblyman Ken Gray, Representing District 39, who is an affiliate member of our SNRW club. We had a good discussion with him on how the legislative session was going and updates on specific bills. Those wanting to sit on the Assembly Floor with assembly members were welcomed. Most importantly, we were honored to have Governor Lombardo speak to our entire group. The legislative session is a very busy time, so when elected officials make time out of the incredibly busy and fast-paced schedule for the constituents and stakeholder input, it shows that they



are interested in hearing about good policy.

I encourage everyone to visit our capitol. It is a very welcoming building, and it is interesting to see the legislative process both at the com-

mittee level and on the Assembly and Senate floor. I used to spend time in the capitol, and it has been limited and was closed off to the public for some while due to COVID precautions. Without being able to go to the capitol during that time, I realized how much I miss the face-to-face interaction with those in the building. You don't appreciate something until you don't have it anymore. Many of the discussions regarding legislation and goals happen in the hallways. It is a learning experience to talk to other interested parties and hear the pros and cons to understand the purpose and motivation behind these bills.

If you are unable to visit the Capitol building, you can still be involved by tracking legislation on Nelis, which is a website that tracks all of the bills in the Nevada Legislature and is a comprehensive database: www.leg.state.nv.us. I am grateful to have attended with other Sierra Nevada Republican Women and represent our club. It was a great networking experience meeting members of our sister clubs at the event. Membership Report



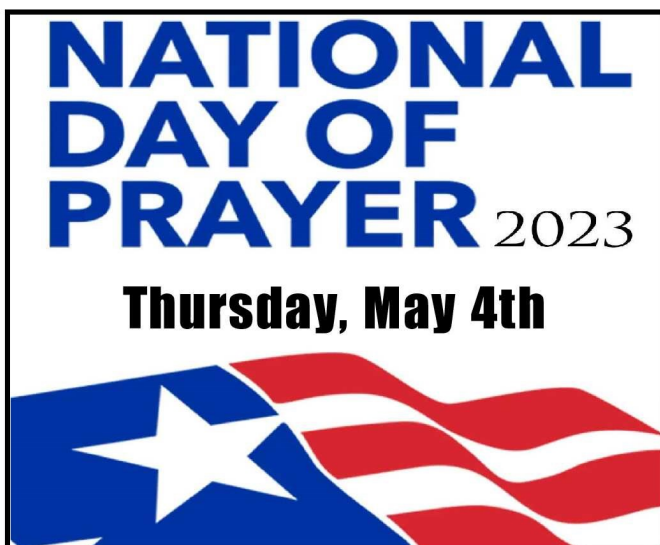

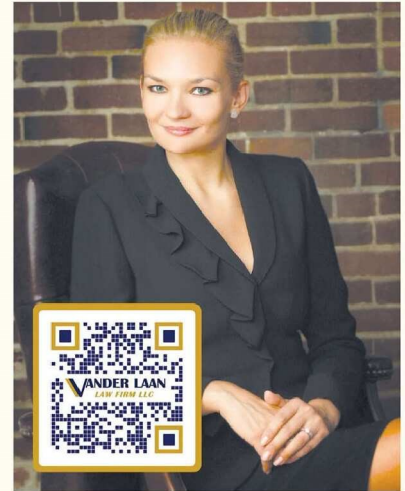
